

Tunica County CDC's Newest Development

Tunica County Community Development coalition, Inc. entered into a contract with Hawthorne Custom Construction out of Kosciusko Mississippi to build the \$2.1 Oscar Price, Jr. Estates in the Orchard Subdivision of Robinsonville Mississippi.

The eight duplex multifamily development will consist of sixteen units of affordable housing in the Robinsonville Community. The project is being funded by HOME Investment Partnership Grant funds awarded to Tunica County CDC by the Mississippi Development Authority and GAP financing from the non-profits long time funder LISC (Local Initiative Support Corporation).

The development is named in honor of Oscar Price, Jr. for his dedicated service and commitment as a longtime member of the Board of Education and as President of the Tunica Chapter of the NAACP.

James Dunn, Executive Director of Tunica County CDC anticipates the units will be available for occupancy in March 2017. The Groundbreaking for the project is scheduled for August 23, 2016.
